JOSHUA RAUH

Joshua D. Rauh is a senior fellow at the Hoover Institution and the Ormond Family Professor of Finance at the Stanford Graduate School of Business. He formerly served at the White House where he was Principal Chief Economist on the President's Council of Economic Advisers. Rauh studies corporate investment, business taxation, government pension liabilities, and investment management.



JOHN TAYLOR

John B. Taylor is the George P. Shultz Senior Fellow in Economics at the Hoover Institution and the Mary and Robert Raymond Professor of Economics at Stanford University. He chairs the Hoover Working Group on Economic Policy and is director of Stanford's Introductory Economics Center.

John Yoo is the Emanuel S. Heller Professor of law at the University of California-Berkeley School of Law (Boalt Hall) and a visiting scholar at the American Enterprise Institute. From 2001 to 2003 he served as Deputy Assistant Attorney General in the Office of Legal Council in the Justice Department of President George W. Bush.
